Dramatic Play Permission Slip

My child _____ may participate in the various dramatic play activities provided to all the children and throughout the school year. During the summer program, as well as the traditional school year, students may participate in body and face painting activities. Students may also participate in “Spa” or “Hair Salon” day (age appropriateness considered), in which children may place nail polish, and designs onto fingernails, and create hair styles for teachers, family members, and their friends.

AMA uses non-toxic body/face paint, which is purchased from the “Lakeshore” teaching supplies store. AMA will also purchase non-toxic nail polish and remover to promote health further for students.

AMA values the experience of theatrical play as a gateway to stimulating the imagination, which further allows children to recognize and practice social roles, and more importantly to develop the emotional skills of a child when role playing. ~The state standards, or Pre-K foundations demonstrate that “to learn, is to provide a context for *creating more complex sequences of pretend play that involve planning, coordination of roles, and cooperation* (California Preschool Learning Foundations, Social Interaction, Interaction with Peers, 2.2) “.
